Five Officers, including the Commanding Officer, Lieutenant Harry Raby Royal Naval Reserve, and fifty ratings were lost, and a further four officers and thirty-nine ratings were taken prisoner. On the following day, the Meteor encountered superior British forces and scuttled herself, Ramsey's crew returning home in the Undaunted.
